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JRF Receives "CASBEE for Building" Certifications

Japan Retail Fund Investment Corporation ("JRF") announced that three of its properties (AEON Itabashi Shopping Center, AEON Naha Shopping Center, and Ito-Yokado Yotsukaido) acquired, in February, 2018, CASBEE's S rank (the highest ranking out of four levels) for building certification from the CASBEE certification board, which is recognized by the Institute for Building Environment and Energy Conservation.

1. Background of Acquisition of Certifications

JRF has been promoting environmental and energy conservation measures as well as the efficient use of energy in its properties in an effort to strengthen environmental consciousness and reduce environmental load. JRF focuses exclusively on retail properties, and has been making environmental efforts in cooperation with tenants in its properties.

As part of efforts for acquiring external evaluation on such initiatives, we received CASBEE for Building certifications, which are evaluation indexes in which a third-party organization evaluates and certifies the accuracy of the evaluation of buildings performed by CASBEE, and which was released in May 2012. Certification for AEON Itabashi Shopping Center was acquired jointly with the tenant, AEON Retail Co., Ltd.; for AEON Naha Shopping Center jointly with the tenant, AEON RYUKYU CO., LTD.

3. Overview of the CASBEE for Building Certifications

CASBEE (Comprehensive Assessment System for Building Environmental Efficiency) is an evaluation system that evaluates and ranks buildings and structures in terms of their environmental performance. In addition to each building's ability to reduce its environmental impact across a variety of areas including energy and resource conservation as well as recycling, this system comprehensively evaluates the environmental performance of each building and structure including its aesthetic appeal.

JRF announced on March 6, 2015, March 4, 2016, and March 17, 2017 that ten of its properties (AEON MALL Musashi Murayama, AEON MALL Tsurumi Ryokuchi, AEON MALL Itami, Higashi-Totsuka Aurora City, AEON Tobata Shopping Center, AEON MALL Sapporo Hassamu, AEON MALL Yamato, Ario Otori, AEON MALL Kobe Kita, AEON MALL Sapporo Naebo) have acquired CASBEE for Building certificates.
