Revision to Dividend Forecast (Dividend Increase)

FP Corporation (the “Company”) announces that it resolved at the meeting of the Board of Directors held on April 30, 2026, to revise the amount of year-end dividend forecast (for the fiscal year ended March 31, 2026) with March 31, 2026, as the record date. Details are as follows.

1. Reason for the revision

The Company positions the return of profits to shareholders as a top priority. Its basic policy is to aim for a consolidated dividend payout ratio of 40%, without reducing dividends in principle, and to pay progressive dividends.

Based on the above policy, the Company had previously set the year-end dividend at 40.00 yen per share. However, as profit attributable to owners of the parent exceeded the earnings forecast, the Company will revise the dividend to 41.50 yen per share, an increase of 1.50 yen. As a result of this revision, the consolidated dividend payout ratio is expected to be 39.7%.
