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Announcement Regarding the Acquisition of Prosper Graph Co., Ltd. to Strengthen the Visual Communication Business in Japan

- Acquisition of Prosper Graph Co., Ltd. Shares by Our Consolidated Subsidiary (Making It a Sub-subsidiary)-

We hereby announce that KOKUSAI PULP & PAPER CO., LTD. ("KPP"), a consolidated subsidiary of KPP Group Holdings Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Chuo-ku, Tokyo), it has acquired all outstanding shares of Prosper Graph Co., Ltd. (Head Office: Shibuya-ku, Tokyo; hereinafter "Prosper Graph"), a company with strengths in the design, production, and installation of in-store promotional materials and other visual merchandising solutions as part of its visual communication business. Details are provided below.

1. Reason for the Shares Acquisition

Our Group is advancing the full-scale development of its Visual Communication Business within the Northeast Asia segment (Japan). As market conditions and customer needs continue to evolve, we believe that, in addition to providing high-quality products and services, it is essential to accumulate expertise in design, planning, and production, while strengthening our proposal capabilities in order to contribute to enhancing our customers' brand value.

Prosper Graph specializes in store design, the planning and production of promotional and decorative materials, and installation services for fashion apparel and sports brands. The company possesses strong creative planning capabilities and extensive industry expertise centered on design.

Through this acquisition, we will integrate Prosper Graph's creative strengths and customer-driven insights with our existing sales capabilities for visual communication-related products, including inkjet media, printers, and inks. This will enable us to enhance our proposal capabilities and solution development expertise within the Visual Communication Business. Furthermore, by leveraging synergies with our Group's business infrastructure and networks both in Japan and overseas, we aim to create new customer value and expand our business domains.
