Notice Regarding Judgment in Lawsuit Against Subsidiaries of the Company

In the patent infringement lawsuit filed against subsidiaries of the Company, Kioxia Corporation and Kioxia America, Inc. ("Kioxia"), described in "Notice Regarding Jury Verdict in Lawsuit Against Subsidiaries of the Company" released on July 17, 2026, the United States District Court for the Western District of Texas rendered a judgment on July 31, 2026 (U.S. time).

4. Background of the Lawsuit and Events Leading Up to the Judgment

On November 29, 2021 (U.S. time), a lawsuit was filed alleging that certain Kioxia products infringed one of the plaintiff's patent claims.

In the lawsuit in question the Company contested that there was no infringement. However, following the jury verdict on July 16, 2026 (U.S. time), the Company was rendered a judgment on July 31, 2026 (U.S. time).

5. Summary of the Verdict and Amount of Damages

The United States District Court for the Western District of Texas ordered Kioxia to pay the following in damages based on the verdict.

Amount of damages: 229 million USD (approximately 36.6 billion yen*)

*Conversion rate: 1 USD = 160 yen

6. Response

Kioxia respects intellectual property rights and strongly disagrees with Viasat, Inc.'s claims and the judgment in this case that certain Kioxia products infringe the single patent claim. We will continue to pursue all legal avenues available to us to correct what we believe to be an erroneous judgment in this case, including post-trial motions and, if necessary, appeal. This judgment does not have an impact on Kioxia's ability to serve its customers.

Following the jury verdict the Company estimated a loss for the legal fees that may arise as a result of this lawsuit and recorded the 229 million USD that would be necessary as provisions for losses on litigation for the first quarter of the fiscal year ending March 2027. The Company will make announcements as necessary going forward.
