Keigo Higashino's New Novel "Eien no Kioku" Launches Work Page on note's AI Context Network



"Eien no Kioku" (published by Bungeishunju on August 5), the latest full-length novel in Keigo Higashino's Galileo series, has launched an official work page on "AI Context Network," a feature on note that aggregates fan reviews and official information for individual works.

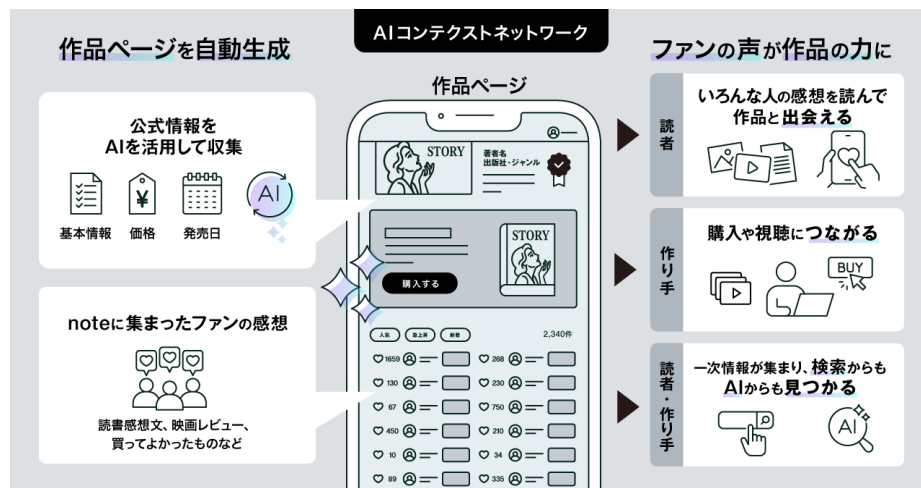
Numerous reviews for Keigo Higashino's works have been posted on note, with over 6,100 articles using the hashtag "#KeigoHigashino." As the Galileo series marks 30 years since its debut in 1996, many posts have also been shared using work-specific hashtags, including "#TheDevotionofSuspectX" and "#SilentParade."

When readers post their thoughts on "Eien no Kioku"—such as lingering surprises, quiet emotions, or memorable lines—using the hashtag "#EienNoKioku," their reviews will be gathered on the work page. This applies to both long-time fans of the series and new readers alike. Through the AI Context Network, users can compare these submitted reviews and connect with the sentiments of other fans.

About the AI Context Network

This system uses AI to automatically generate pages that gather fan reviews and official information for each work or product. It currently supports books, videos, and games, with plans to expand to all categories in the future. note has hosted about 150 official posting campaigns, including "#BookReview" and "#MovieReview." The cumulative number of submitted reviews and articles has reached approximately 2 million.



Readers visiting a work's page can discover their next read by exploring various people's reviews. For creators, fan feedback encourages others to purchase or view their works. Centralizing primary information makes the works easier to find via searches and AI. Fan voices become the strength of the works. The AI Context Network is a system designed to create this positive cycle.

Book Reviews Expanding Across note

A culture of writing personal book reviews has taken root on note. For Keigo Higashino's works, a wide variety of articles has accumulated. These include book reviews discussing the thrill of the mysteries, analyses of characters like Manabu Yukawa and Kaoru Utsumi, guide articles suggesting reading orders for the series, and essays where readers relate the works to their own experiences.

With the release of "Eternal Memory," we expect a further increase in reviews and analyses of the new book, as well as thoughts on the entire Galileo series. On the work's page, users can compare different reviews and share their own post-reading impressions with other fans.
